New speaker.

A bit impudent, that one. We come here, because does the Lord have children out here in the world and not reach down, not reach out to assist them? Would the Lord do that? No. The Lord shows his children how to be, and the only way that the Lord can show his children how to be is to be amongst them. That is why we come. That is what motivates us. Not everybody wants to be among strangers. Not everybody wants to be among you, but we do. Why? Because you are listening to us, and because you are listening to us, we choose to come amongst you, whether we whisper into your ear and the medium speaks, or whether we're able to slip inside the medium and speak for ourselves. We do this because we desire you to be more than what you are today, and there's only one way that can happen. That is for someone to teach you. Am I correct?

We come to class to learn. Fortunately, not everyone in this country prefers to be out in the gathering houses, the saloons, the places of drink. It was the worst invention that anybody could come up with. Although I should not say that because it has its uses and people are weak, and we are here to help you be strong. Because the Lord wants all of you to be strong. To be strong in all that you do. The Lord teaches love and for us to understand love, we need others to come and speak to us about it, to speak to you about it. I think I said something the last time I was here when Mr. Falcone allowed me in about his interpretation of love, which is to nurture; and to nurture. Is that not what the Lord does is nurture all of us; each of us, nurture us, encourage us to be more, to be better, to be more than what we dream that we can be? Is that not good? Think about it.

## New speaker.

One must come here because you are here. Some of us come here because this one has called upon us. We are teachers, and teachers answer the call to teach. When the student is ready, the teaching shows up. Therefore, when this student is ready we show up to teach. This student is here to teach you and through him we teach. As you are learning, all of us have different reasons, different motivations, as you put it. To be here. What matters is that you are here to listen. That is the important thing, to listen and to ask questions when you do not understand something. This one continuously seeks what he calls secret knowledge. He calls it secret knowledge because you cannot find it in books, some things you just cannot write. It's not that you can't write, it's just because you cannot find the proper words to convey what is being taught. Now, we gave this one a very perplexing teaching. I will share this teaching with you, but we will not explore it, but I want to give you an example of what this one considers secret knowledge. You can always tell someone who frequents those places because they always stretch everything and only this much of it (indicating a small amount) is actually true. What can I say? After my brother helped me up and introduced me to these, to this strange practice, I would sit and I would listen, but not everything they said made sense. They didn't like those things. When Mr. Franklin got all of this organized and everything, and you know

That explained a lot. So, back to this here. It's not that you have to have questions. We come here to share our thoughts. Sometimes, if you're thinking is clear enough, we pick up on your thoughts, and then we can expound on those thoughts. Mr. Lincoln, before he became president, he would sit in someone's seances. He was in New York, and he would come and sit, and he would have his pencil and paper, just like this one and you, he had his pencil and paper, and you'd always see him writing, but you never heard him ask a question. So, when you come to these things, when you come to these meetings, and I can't wait for the rest of them to get back here, but when you come to these meetings, you don't necessarily have to voice it, just focus on it. We might hear you. Especially if this one doesn't have so many thoughts, and he's always got cluttered thoughts. He's always worried. Worried he's going to say the wrong thing, worried that he's that he's going to.... He's never sure about any of this stuff. That's what makes it so fun with him.
